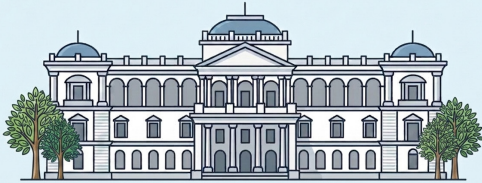

THE GOVERNANCE WINS (MACRO-LEVEL OPTIMISM)

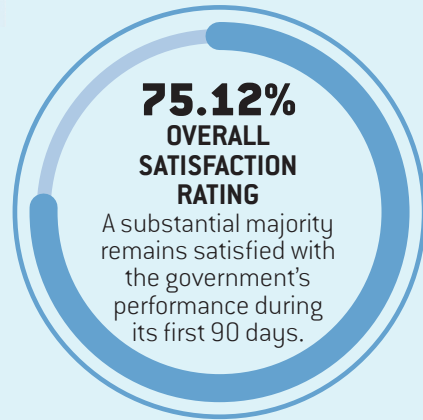
ANTI-CORRUPTION IS THE DEFINING SUCCESS

Improvements in public services (ward, municipal, and administrative offices) have significantly reduced everyday bureaucratic friction.



THE ECONOMIC STRUGGLE (MICRO-LEVEL REALITY)

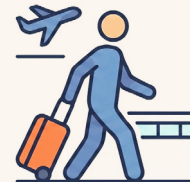
54.98% DISSATISFIED WITH INFLATION CONTROL

High cost-of-living remains the primary source of pain for the average household.



THE SQUATTER EVICTION PARADOX

Squatter clearance from public land has 71.56% support; the management of these evictions is also the most disliked government action.



STAGNANT YOUTH OUT-MIGRATION

54.34% of respondents report no change in the volume of youth leaving the country.
